## Flow of events & Transportation

(for students and tutors)

### **DAY 1 (Oct. 4, 2017) – Sapienza University, Piazzale Aldo Moro, 5 - Rectorate (Aula Magna)**

Participants will reach the venue on their own, and will be free to go after the afternoon reception, therefore no transportation has been arranged for this day.

### **DAY 2 (Oct. 5, 2017) – Tor Vergata University, Via Columbia, 2 - Faculty of Economics (Aula Magna)**

Participants will be picked up by Conference Staff in the hotel lobbies at 8 o'clock and directed to the buses that will take them to Tor Vergata University. The buses will leave from Piazza dell'Indipendenza (a 5-minute walk from the hotels) at around 8.15.

### **DAY 3 (Oct. 6, 2017)**

**Roma Tre University, Via Ostiense, 234 - Faculty of Humanities (Aula Conferenze)**

**Foro Italico University, Piazza Lauro De Bosis, 6 – Main Building**

Participants will be picked up by Conference Staff in the hotel lobbies and directed to the buses that will take them to Roma Tre University. The buses will leave from Piazza dell'Indipendenza at around 8.15 (same as DAY 2). After lunch, students and their tutors will be taken to Foro Italico University by bus for the afternoon and evening programme. Transportation to the hotels will be available after dinner.

*Please note that this is the longest day of the Conference, lasting from early morning until late evening.*

### **DAY 4 (Oct. 7, 2017) – Sapienza University, Piazzale Aldo Moro, 5 - Rectorate (Aula**

**Magna)** Participants will reach the venue on their own, and will be free to go after lunch, therefore no transportation has been arranged for this day.

### **DAY 5 (Oct. 8, 2017) – Hotel Archimede, Via dei Mille, 19**

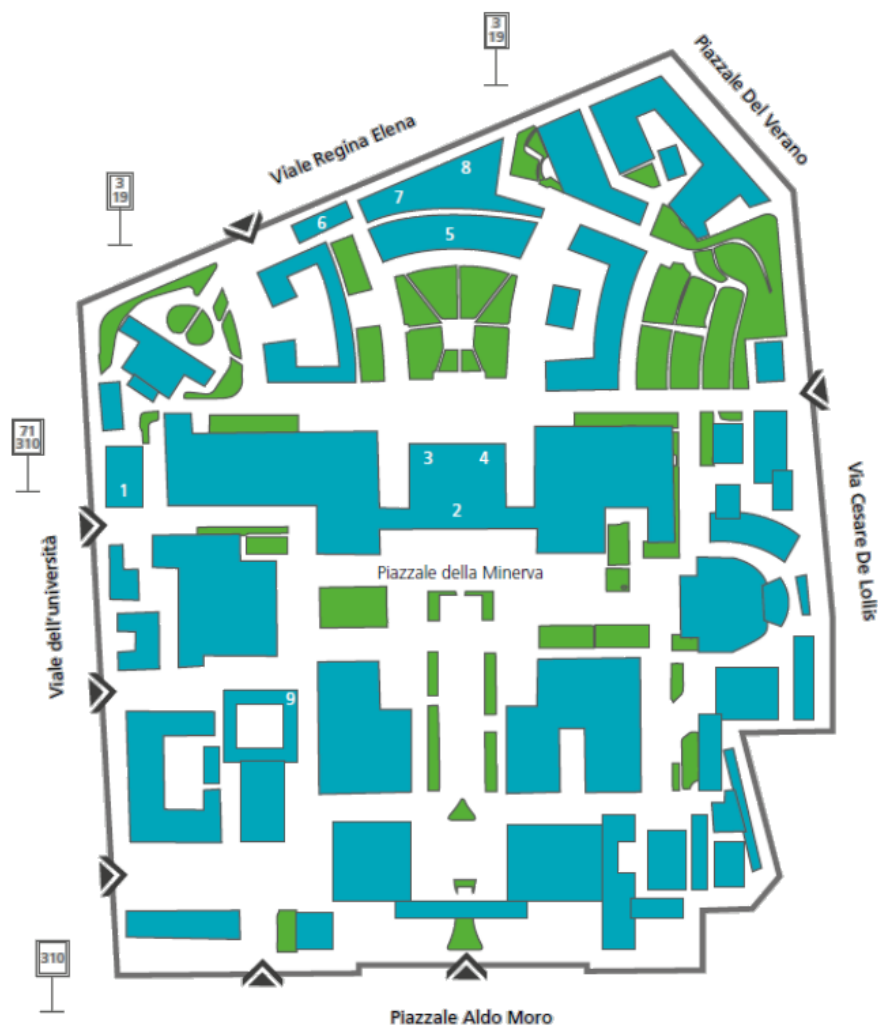
Farewell address in the lobby of Hotel Archimede. No transportation has been arranged for this day.

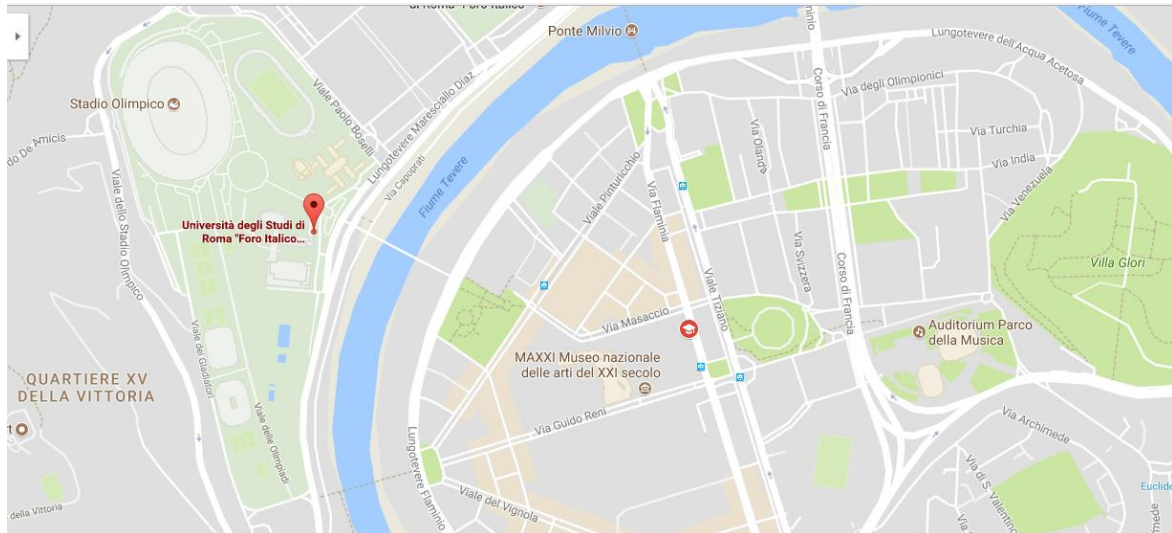
The Conference will take place in via Ostiense 234, near the Marconi Station of the Subway B Line (Faculty of Humanities, Aula Conferenze, ground floor)

The Conference will take place at Piazza Lauro de Bosis, 15 - Foro Italico- Roma 00194, near the Olympic Stadium.



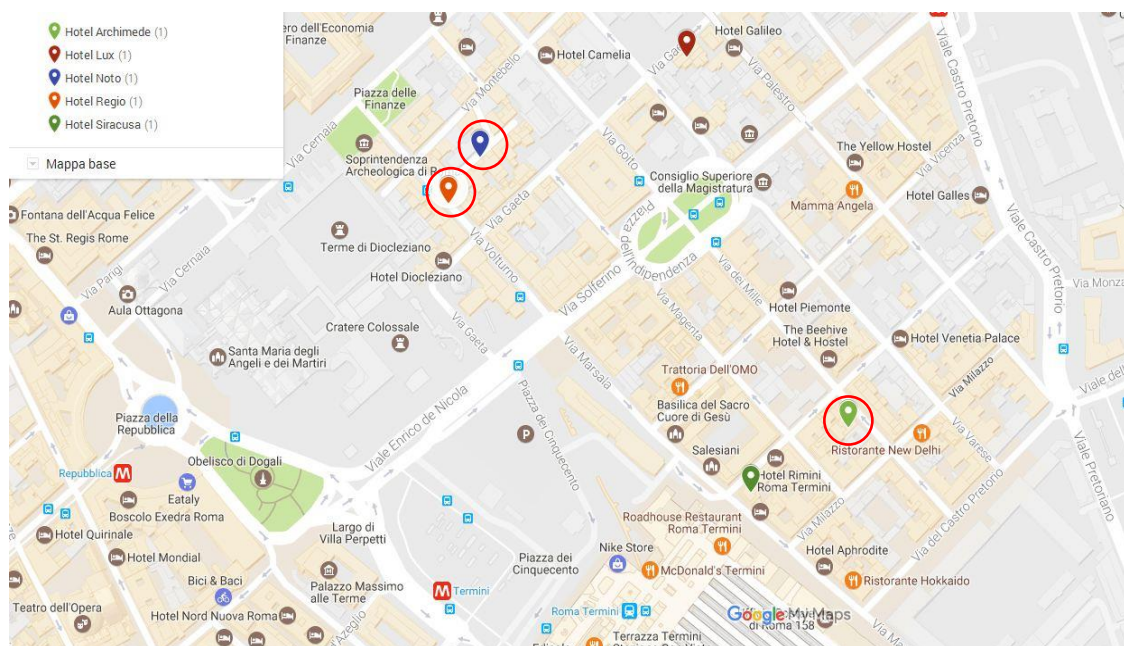

## Getting to Rome

### From Rome Fiumicino Airport

#### By train (Leonardo Express) → to Termini Station:

Tickets: € 14.00

Fiumicino -> Termini Station

Every 30 minutes: from 6:23 to 23:23

Termini Station -> Fiumicino

Every 30 minutes: from 5:35 to 22:35

Please note: Leonardo Express train makes no mid-journey stops. Route time: 35 minutes

#### By train (Regional Train) → to Tiburtina Station:

Tickets: € 8.00

Fiumicino > Tiburtina Station > Fiumicino (every 15 minutes from Monday to Saturday, every 30 minutes on Sundays). Route time: 47 minutes

#### By Shuttle Bus:

The bus line Terravision Shuttle Bus connects Fiumicino Airport with Termini train station. Tickets: €9 One-way or €15 return (cheaper prices available on the web), total duration: 60 minutes. Other companies also operate this route.

#### By taxi:

There are fix fares from downtown to the airport. City centre to Fiumicino and vice-versa ranges around €48. Luggage fee is around 1 euro per bag. Be aware that Fiumicino is outside of city limits, therefore the starting fare from the airport is higher (2<sup>nd</sup> price range), however the driver should switch back to fare 1 as soon as you reach the ring road (G.R.A) signalling the entrance to city limits. You can also opt for a shared taxi (door-to-door): [www.airportshuttle.it](http://www.airportshuttle.it), which you can book online at single fare of €25 (from Fiumicino airport to the hotel).

### From Rome Ciampino Airport:

#### By bus (non-stop transfer to Termini station):

Rome Ciampino airport can be reached via different bus routes. Daily direct connections between the airport and FS Roma Termini station are guaranteed by the bus services operated by ATRAL, COTRAL, SIT and TERRAVISION. The buses are parked in dedicated bus bays by the exit for International Departures. Tickets can be bought directly from the bus driver.

### By train:

The nearest railway station is Ciampino Città station, connected to/from the airport by the following buses: COTRAL/SCHIAFFINI. Both buses depart every 30 minutes and **tickets** can be bought in the bus and on the ground and they cost € 1,20. The travelling time is about 5 minutes. From Ciampino Città station, you can take a train to Termini station. Departures are frequent (every 15 minutes) and it takes about 20 minutes.

### By metro:

The nearest metro station is Anagnina, connected to/from the airport by buses COTRAL/SCHIAFFINI leaving every 30 minutes. Once at Anagnina, take the line A (red line), which makes several stops in the city centre, including Termini station.

### By taxi:

There are fix fares from downtown to airports. City centre to Ciampino and vice-versa cost 30 Euros. Luggage fee is about €1 per bag.

## Getting around the city

### Public transport

Metrebus, Rome's public transport system, integrates a variety of different transport services: underground/tube, urban trains, buses and trams. There are several different types of Metrebus tickets that can be bought at ticket offices, newsagents, tobacconists and automatic machines in stations. You should not board on the public transport without a ticket. Please remember that you must always validate your ticket at the beginning of your journey and when transferring onto the metro (your ticket must be re-stamped within 100 minutes from the first validation stamp and is then valid until the end of your journey on the metro). It is only valid for one metro journey, but you can take more than one bus.

You must keep your ticket with you while travelling on public transport and be ready to show it, on request, to ticket inspectors.

Most buses run from 5:30am to 12:00am (night buses are available after midnight). Underground trains run from 5:30pm to 11:30pm Sunday to Thursday and from 5:30am to 1:30am on Fridays and Saturdays.

Types of Tickets:

- a) BIT - Integrated Time Ticket:
  - costs € 1.50 and lasts 100 minutes from the initial validation;
  - only one metro or train journey is permitted.
- b) Daily Pass:
  - costs €6 and is valid until midnight of the validation day for an unrestricted number of journeys.

## Taxis

Taxis in Rome are white, have an identification name and number on the front door and are equipped with a taximeter. They can be easily found in every part of the city at special taxi ranks, or you can call one of the numerous Radio Taxi companies like 06 3570, 06 6645, 06 8822, 06 4157, 06 4994 or 06 5551.
